What Is <<Project / Org Name>> Community Solar?

<< Project >> community solar is a large solar system that members of the community can join to share the benefits of the solar energy that's generated. This is great for people who don't want to install their own rooftop solar, or who rent or live in apartments or condominiums. The energy generated by << Project >> goes to the utility energy grid, and the value of that energy is shared by all subscribers in the form of credits on your utility bill. So you can feel good about supporting clean, renewable energy without paying the upfront costs of your own rooftop solar.



Who's Eligible?

Any << Utility >> customer can subscribe to the << Project >>.

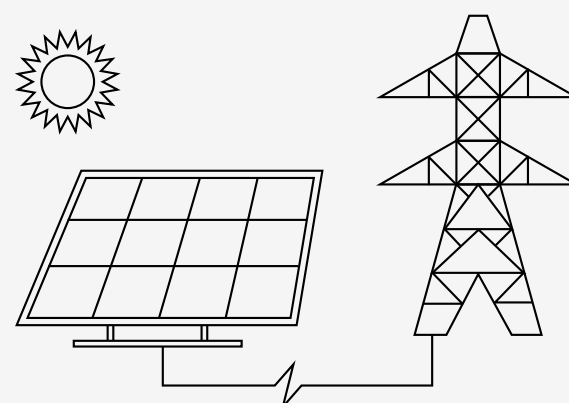

How It Works

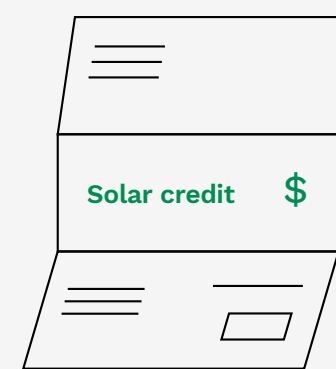
When you subscribe to << Project >>, you pay a monthly subscription fee for a portion of the energy generated by the project. You then receive a credit on your utility bill each month for the amount of energy generated by your portion of the project.
